

Scientific and Technical Committee Regulation

Art. 1 -The Scientific and Technical Committee is chaired by the President- Director.

Art. 2- The Scientific and Technical Committee consists of Scholars and/or Teachers who have titles and scientific requirements. They hold office for 3 years and give their services without charge.

Art. 3- The Scientific and Technical Committee is an Advisory body.

The Council members:

- give an opinion about the orientation and development of the magazine;
- suggest topics to be discussed in the articles and any authors who ask for scientific collaboration;
- collaborate to "Blind Reviewing", keep high the scientific level of the magazine with their titles, their qualifications, their skills and with the contribution of their scientific work in individual or collaborative form;
- may propose the appointment of new members in the same Scientific and Technical Committee;
- hold office for 3 years. In the absence of written communication the renewal of office according to the formula of "tacit renewal" is meant;

Art. 4 - The composition of the Scientific and Technical Committee is no more than 20 members, and consists of Italian and/ or foreign personalities of high scientific value.

Art. 5 – It will be given appropriate visibility on the magazine website about the members of the Scientific and Technical Committee and of their curriculum vitae, operum et honorum and their names will be entered in the magazine colophon.

Art. 6- In case a member should leave office he is not entitled to any claim for services offered to the benefit of the magazine.

Art. 7- The "Blind Reviewers" are obliged to express their opinion on the articles that will be submitted to them within 30 days subsequent the receipt of the drafts and however within 30 days preceding the date of publication. In case of negative opinion a written motivation is required.
